



4 DAYS SOUTH ISLAND TOUR (CHRISTCHURCH)

Day-01 Arrive in Christchurch

Arrive at Christchurch International Airport. Meet & greet on arrival and airport seat-in-coach transfer to your hotel for check in. Enjoy free time on own leisure. Overnight at hotel.

Day-02: Christchurch City Tour (B)

Discover the fascinating history of Christchurch on a half day city sightseeing tour. Take in the sights of the central city and its surrounds and see how this beautiful city is recovering from the devastating 2011 earthquake. Step on board a classic open top double decker for a one-hour bus tour around central Christchurch. Your guide will tell you about the history of the city from its pioneering days to the present day. You will view some of the areas affected by the earthquakes, see how Christchurch is preserving some of its iconic heritage buildings and learn about the latest plans for restoration of the inner city.

Experience the natural beauty of Hagley Park, the Avon River and Botanic Gardens, as well as the recently reopened New Regent Street with its distinctive Spanish Mission style architecture, and the Re:START mall, an innovative development created entirely out of shipping containers!

Following your Christchurch city tour, we head towards the picturesque seaside village of Sumner where there is time to explore the beach and its interesting rock formations. From there we travel up the Port Hills to the historic Sign of the Takahe, a listed heritage building where you will enjoy panoramic views overlooking Christchurch City, the port of Lyttelton,

the Canterbury Plains and the Southern Alps. On the return journey we visit Mona Vale, one of Christchurch's most spectacular gardens. Take a leisurely stroll around the park and see why Christchurch is known as 'the Garden City'.

Afternoon free at your own leisure.

Useful tips: The first hour of this tour is by open top double decker bus with covered seating available downstairs. The last two hours of the tour are in a closed top double decker vehicle.

Day-03: Mt. Cook Day Tour (B)

Our tour departs Christchurch in the morning and travels through the lush farmland of the Canterbury Plains to Lake Tekapo, where you can see the iconic Church of the Good Shepherd as it stands in solitude next to the vibrant blue waters. Leaving Tekapo, we to see the highest mountain peak in the country and enjoy the serene alpine vista. Continue the journey back to Christchurch. Along the way your driver guide will keep you entertained and informed with commentary on the area's history and sites of interest.

Day-04: Depart Christchurch (B)

Free time until check out from your hotel and transfer to Christchurch International Airport for your flight bound for home, taking with you the unforgettable and fond memories of a wonderful of New Zealand.
