DAY-03: SOVEREIGN HILL WITH WILDLIFE (B)

Add a wildlife aspect to your day out to Sovereign Hill with opportunity to visit Ballarat Wildlife Park. Nestled in a native bushland habitat, get up close to many of the Australian animals such as kangaroos, koalas and emus.

If you are yet to have an Australian wildlife encounter, you will definitely be impressed with Ballarat Wildlife Park. Join a guided tour and meet our friendly kangaroos (and many of them too), shy koalas and Tasmanian devils. Continue to Sovereign Hill, an authentic re-creation of the 1850's gold mining town of Ballarat. There are so many things to see and do here!

 Tour through Ballarat, taking in its period buildings and statues and learn some of its history
 Eureka Stockade - site of the 1854 miner's rebellion

 Feed free range Kangaroos
 Experience an Emu encounter
 Meet our cute cuddly Koalas
 See Tasmanian Devils feeding

 Explore the main street and its many original shops or perhaps enjoy Devonshire tea at the New York Bakery?
 See working blacksmiths and traditional craftsmen
 Visit the Chinese Village showcasing Chinese involvement in the goldfields

DAY-04: GREAT OCEAN ROAD (B/L)

One of our top attractions and known the world over for its dramatic and impressive coastline, the Great Ocean Road is a must-see and do when you visit Melbourne. Be treated to a delicious two course lunch at Apollo Bay Hotel. It's one of the best days out you'll have on a Gray Line day tour to iconic Great Ocean Road. Make sure your camera is fully charged because you will certainly be snap happy as you travel along the coast with its spectacular ocean vistas contrasting with serene rainforest.
