DAY-01: WELCOME TO MELBOURNE.

Arrive at Melbourne International or Domestic Airport. Your airport seat-in-coach transfer will take you to your hotel in Melbourne.

Enjoy a relaxed start and a day completely at leisure.

DAY-02: MELBOURNE CITY TOUR & RIVER CRUISE. (BL)

Welcome to Melbourne - home to the Australian Open Tennis, Australian Rules Football and the Melbourne's Cup. Inhabited by people from all over the world, this dynamic city has a very cosmopolitan feel.

This City Sightseeing Tour allows you to immerse yourself in the culture of this magnificent city.

Join our Melbourne city tour and be treated to a morning of informative commentary and colourful atmosphere exploring Fitzroy Gardens, Queen Victoria Market*, a few of our laneways and arcades and a drive through Chinatown. At the conclusion of our city tour, take a little walk down to the riverside to join a scenic and relaxing cruise on the Yarra River. It's also a great photo opportunity to capture Melbourne's distinct and spectacular city skyline.

DAY-03: GREAT OCEAN ROAD. (BL)

One of our top attractions and known the world over for its dramatic and impressive coastline, the Great Ocean Road is a must-see and do when you visit Melbourne.

It's one of the best days out you'll have on a Gray Line day tour to iconic Great Ocean Road. Make sure your camera is fully charged because you will certainly be snap happy as you travel along the coast with its spectacular ocean vistas contrasting with serene rainforest. Lunch is provided at Apollo Bay Hotel after which we will then visit the star attractions of Port Campbell National Park, also known as "The Shipwreck Coast". View the Twelve Apostles from the board walk and explore Loch Ard Gorge.

Be treated to a delicious two course lunch at Apollo Bay Hotel.

DAY-04: SOVEREIGN HILL TOUR WITH WILDLIFE. (B)

Add a wildlife aspect to your day out to Sovereign Hill with opportunity to visit Ballarat Wildlife Park. Nestled in a native bushland habitat, get up close to many of the Australian animals such as kangaroos, koalas and emus.

If you are yet to have an Australian wildlife encounter, you will definitely be impressed with Ballarat Wildlife Park. Join a guided tour and meet our friendly kangaroos (and many of them too), shy koalas and Tasmanian devils. Continue to Sovereign Hill, an authentic re-creation of the 1850's gold mining town of Ballarat. There are so many things to see and do here! Take in the atmosphere of Main Street, try gold panning, take the Red Hill Mine tour, explore the Chinese Village and visit the Gold Museum.

Highlights of this tour

- Tour through Ballarat, taking in its period buildings and statues and learn some of its history
- Eureka Stockade - site of the 1854 miner's rebellion
- Ballarat Wildlife Park, owned by the Parker family, is home to a host of native Australian animals including Patrick, Australia's most famous wombat
- Join a guided tour of the Wildlife Park

- Feed free range Kangaroos, Experience an Emu encounter, Meet our cute cuddly Koalas, See Tasmanian Devils feeding, See Goannas and giant Lizards
- At Sovereign Hill experience the authentic recreation of an 1850's gold mining town
- Have a go at gold panning in Red Gully Creek
- Head underground and enjoy the Red Hill Mine tour
