

5 DAYS PERTH DISCOVERY TOUR



DAY-01: WELCOME TO PERTH.

Arrive at Perth International or Domestic Airport. Your airport seat-in-coach transfer will take you to your hotel in Perth.

Enjoy a relaxed start and a day completely at leisure.

DAY-02: PERTH CITY TOUR (B)

Tour the city highlights of Perth and it's coastal neighbour Fremantle aboard this morning tour. Take in city and beach views and catch a glimpse of the alfresco lifestyle of the Western Australian capital.

Take in the sights of King's Park Botanical Gardens and it's views back to the city skyline. See the Western Australia Cricket Ground (WACA) and iconic Swan Bell tower at the Barrack Street Jetty as well as the Perth Mint, Old Swan Brewery and St Georges Terrace, Perth's main street. Views of Swan River and the famous Cottesloe beach en-route to the historic port of Fremantle with it's docks, marinas and charming heritage sandstone buildings. Take a stroll on South Terrace and perhaps drop into the local shops or market before returning to Perth to conclude the day.

Highlights of this tour

- The WACA - Western Australia cricket ground

- Visit Kings Park - spectacular views over Perth skyline, Swan River and Melville Water from the tree top walk
- Cottesloe Beach on the Indian Ocean coastline
- Stunning and historic Fremantle - docks, marinas, charming heritage sandstone buildings
- Take a break in Fremantle - perhaps a coffee on South Terrace's cappuccino strip (own expense)
- Barrack Street Jetty
- The Swan Bell Tower
- Perth Mint - stunning sandstone colonial architecture
- Upmarket suburbs of Peppermint Grove and Dalkeith
- Old Swan Brewery and Royal Perth Yacht Club - once home to the America's Cup

DAY-03: PERTH FULL DAY PINNACLES, KOALAS AND SAND BOARDING (B/L)

A fascinating day of spectacular natural contrasts. Big sky plains, koalas and kangaroos, massive sand dunes and emerald waters lapping pristine white sandy beaches.

Then the dramatic Pinnacles Desert - arid, vast seemingly lifeless yet inhabited by strange limestone pillars rising through the sand. The thrilling adventure of four wheel driving at the Lancelin Sand Dunes, is an unparalleled way of discovering this awesome environment.

Highlights of this tour

- Guildford - history and charm on the Perth outskirts
- The Swan Valley - colonial towns, crafts and Western Australia's first wine growing region
- Caversham Wildlife Park - an opportunity to see koalas, wombat and kangaroo close up
- Look for native wildflowers from September through to November
- Cross vast big sky scrub and pasturelands
- Look for kangaroos and emus on the endless plains and scrub land
- Visit a lobster farm on a guided tour
- Enjoy a fish and chips lunch at the Lobster Shack
- Namburg National Park - home of the Pinnacles

- Take a guided walk through the Pinnacles desert and it's limestone pillars created by the forces of nature
- Take a break at the cray fishing port of Lancelin on the Indian Ocean with time for a short stroll on the beach
- Enjoy thrills with giant four wheel driving across and down the massive Lancelin sand dunes - exhilarating!
- Try your hand at sandboarding on the dunes - a really fun experience for any age

DAY-04: **ROTTNESS ISLAND TOUR (B)**

Rottnest Island, set in the warm waters of the Indian Ocean and a short boat cruise from Perth. Explore secluded beaches and isolated sandy bays. Learn of early island settlement history, catch sight of a native quokka!
 Departing Perth by high speed ferry take in the sights along the Swan River and Fremantle before arriving at Rottnest Island. Enjoy free time on arrival at Rottnest. Join a guided 1.5 hour Rottnest Island tour by coach to take in the views of stunning sandy beaches, turquoise water, Wadjemup Lighthouse, coastal heaths and local quokkas. Learn about the island's history and culture and be sure to wander along the boardwalk at West End to soak up the excellent views.

Highlights of this tour

- Transfer to Barrack Street Jetty and board the high speed ferry
- Enjoy views of Perth City and Swan River as you cruise out of Perth with full commentary
- Take a short ocean cruise to Rottnest Island
- Join a 1.5 hour circumnavigation of the island takes you out to some of Rottnest's most spectacular locations and provides you with a complete interpretation of the island via passionate and knowledgeable crew.

- This coach based tour gives you a great introduction to the island.
- Unspoilt white sandy beaches, emerald waters and reefs, boardwalks, coastal heath and meet the local quokkas
- Learn of the island's aboriginal history, diverse wildlife and fauna, historical and social heritage
- You will also have a chance to step outside and have a stroll along the boardwalk at the majestic look-out point at West End
- Identify numerous bird species who call the island home
- Re-board the ferry to complete your sightseeing tour back to Barrack Street Jetty

DAY-05: **DEPART PERTH (B)**

Your journey comes to an end after breakfast. Departure transfers arrive at Perth International or Domestic Airport.
